

Changing Places Improving community access

What is a Changing Place?

Changing Places are secure, clean facilities for people with disability who need space and assistance to use the bathroom when out and about.

Changing Places feature:

- a ceiling hoist
- adult-size change table
- room for two support people

Changing Places are unlocked using a Master Locksmith Access Key (MLAK). The key keeps the Changing Places secure, safe and reserved for people who need them. If you are a Companion Card holder you automatically qualify for a free MLAK. If you aren't a card holder, you may still be eligible.

Next to the Mandurah Visitor Centre

- 75 Mandurah Terrace behind the Visitor Centre
- 24-hour access with own MLAK key
- An MLAK key can be borrowed from the Mandurah Visitor's Centre 7 days a week between 9am - 4pm

Mandurah Aquatic and Recreation Centre

- 303 Pinjarra Road, Mandurah
- · Open during Centre operating hours
- · No MLAK key required

Mandurah Forum

- 330 Pinjarra Road, Mandurah located near the Food Court
- · Open during Centre operating hours
- Temporary keys can be borrowed from the Centre's customer service desk
