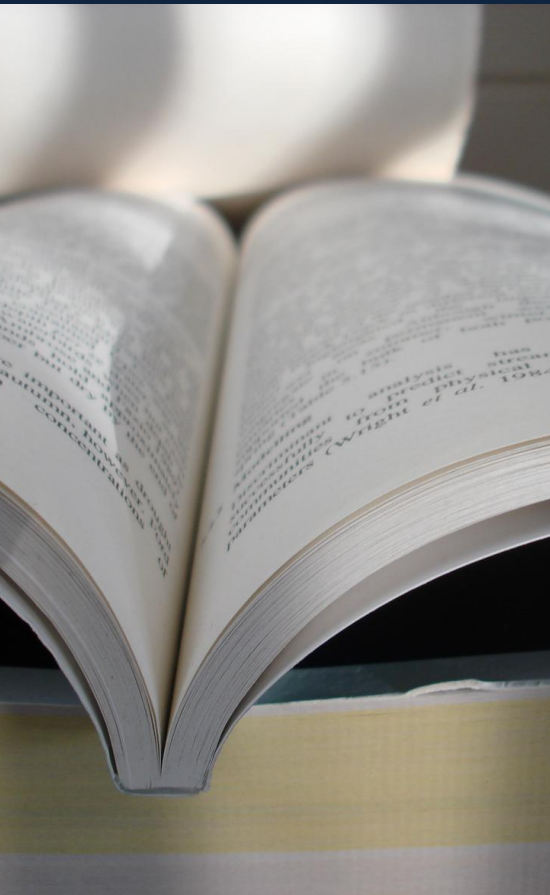

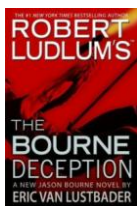
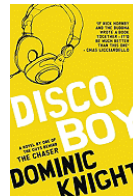


Girl missing / Tess Gerritsen

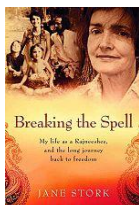
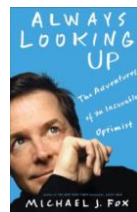
Robert Ludlum's The Bourne deception : a new Jason Bourne novel Eric Van Lustbader

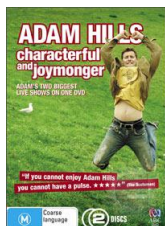
Breaking the spell : my life as a Rajneeshee, and the long journey back to freedom / Jane Stork
