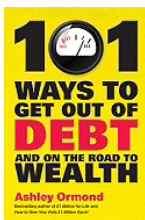

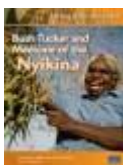
As with her previous two Jill Jackson novels, psychologist Leah Giarratano writes with disturbing insight into the criminal mind.

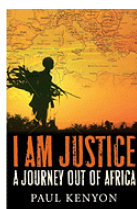
The blood spilt / Asa Larsson
