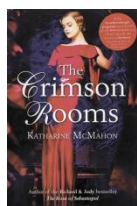

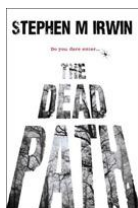


The crimson rooms / Katharine McMahon

This book brings the proven social networking strategies of the business and professional world to your personal life, allowing you to overcome shyness, win friends and make an impact in every social situation..

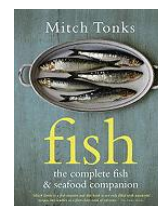


The dead path / Stephen M. Irwin

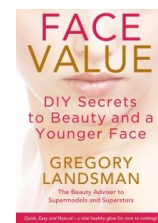
The concrete blonde / Michael Connelly
