QUALIFYING CONDITIONS:

- ◆ Pension or Health Benefit card holders (or persons able to prove financial difficulty) only.
- ◆ Personal identification and benefit card must be produced.
- ◆ Permanent residents of the City of Mandurah only.
- ◆ One dog sterilisation per household only.
- ◆ **Nominated dog must be presented for inspection by Ranger Services** at 5 Pinjarra Road Mandurah (Tel 9550 3630) at time of application.
- ◆ Dog must be sterilised and registered one month from the date the voucher is issued.

PLEASE NOTE

The final decision to sterilise a dog is at the sole discretion of the Veterinarian.

Dogs will not be accepted for the program if any of the following conditions apply:

- In season or pregnant
- Obese
- Too old or in poor health
- Any condition nominated by attending veterinarian.
- Appointments must be made with the participating practices, and sterilisation vouchers and Pension or Health Care cards presented at the visit.
- Payment for the service must be finalised on the day - no accounts will be issued.
