<b>Chairs:</b>	120 Chairs

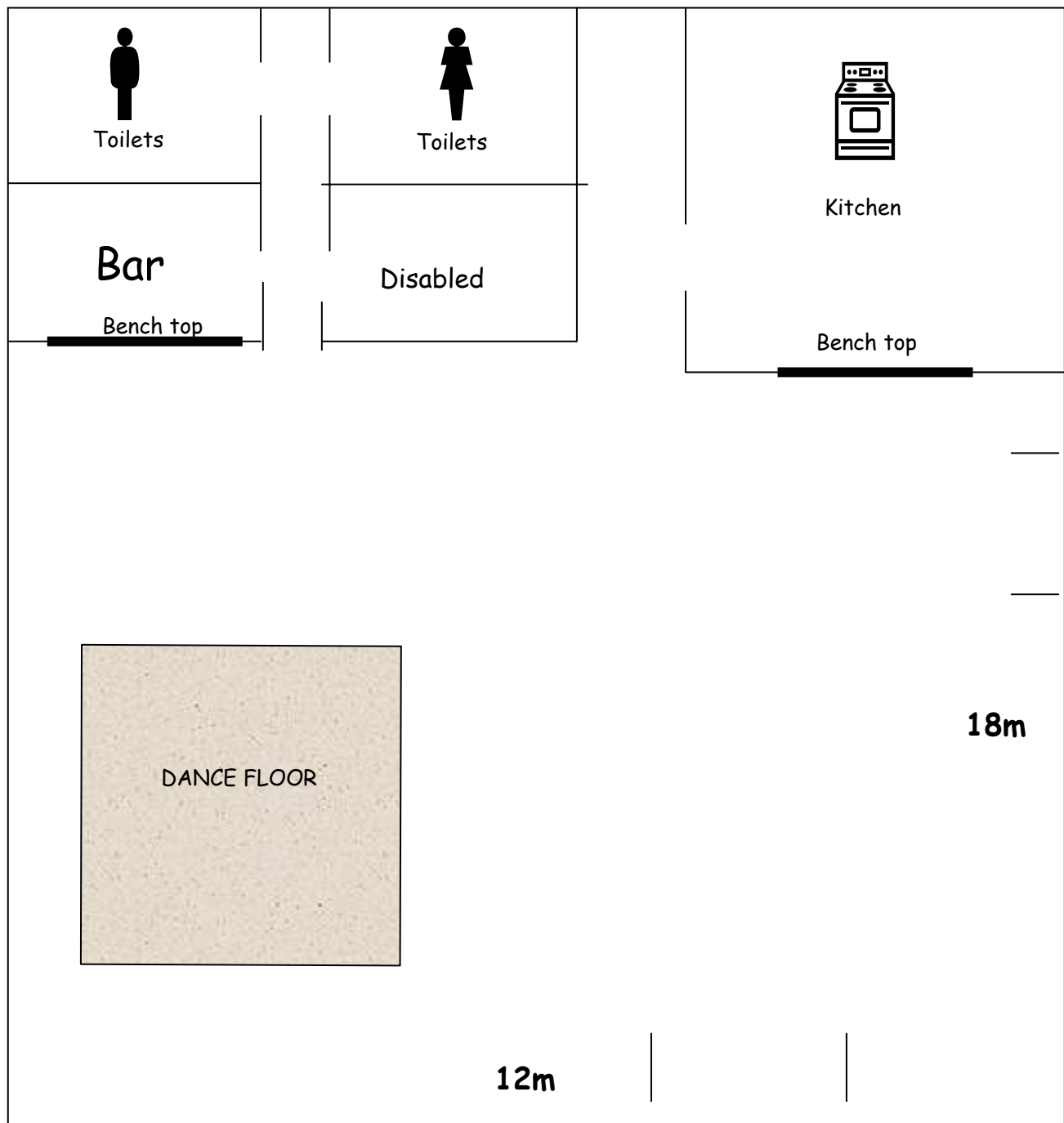
### Kitchen
