

## DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

### CAT ACT 2011

<b>Function to be performed:</b>	<p>To carry out the powers or discharge of any of the duties of Council pursuant to the Cat Act 2011 and Cat Regulations 2012 including but not limited to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Providing notice of decisions relating to the refusal to grant or renew the registration of a cat, or cancel the registration of a cat.</li> <li>2. Granting approval to breed cats.</li> <li>3. Cancelling the approval to breed cats.</li> <li>4. Providing notice of decisions relating to the refusal to approve or renew the approval, or cancel the approval of a person to breed cats.</li> <li>5. Appointing officers to be authorised for the purpose of performing particular functions under the Cat Act 2011.</li> <li>6. Extending the period a modified penalty is to be paid.</li> <li>7. Withdrawing an infringement notice.</li> <li>8. Commencing Prosecutions for an offence against the Cat Act 2011.</li> <li>9. Reducing or waiving the registration fees in respect of any individual cat or any class of cat within the district.</li> </ol>

<b>Conditions and Exceptions:</b>	1) Sub-delegates are not permitted to undertake the function of appointing authorised officers under section 5 above [s48 of the Act]; 2) Functions under sections 63, 64 or 65 of the Act cannot be delegated to an authorised person; 3) Delegation does not permit any of the delegates to perform the following functions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Making of Local Laws (section 79); or</li> <li>• Governor approval to make local laws outside district (section 80)</li> </ul>
