

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

DISPOSAL OF IMPOUNDED GOODS / VEHICLES

Function to be performed:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) IMPOUNDED GOODS - Sell or otherwise dispose of impounded goods that have not been collected within the period specified in section 3.47(2b) of the date a notice is given under sections 3.42(1)(b) or 3.44. 2) IMPOUNDED VEHICLES - Declare an impounded vehicle an abandoned vehicle wreck in accordance with the provision of section 3.40A. Sell or otherwise dispose of any vehicle that has not been collected within two (2) months of a notice having been given under section 3.40(3) or 7 days of a declaration being made that a vehicle is an abandoned wreck. 3) Refuse to allow impounded goods to be collected until the costs of removing, impounding and keeping them have been paid to the local government.

Express Power or Duty Delegated:	<i>Local Government Act 1995:</i> s.3.46 Goods may be held until costs paid s.3.47 Confiscated or uncollected goods, disposal of s.3.58 Disposing of property s.3.40A Abandoned vehicle wreck may be taken
Conditions / Exceptions of sub-delegation:	<p>IMPOUNDED GOODS - Includes dealings with <i>confiscated</i> goods.</p> <p>IMPOUNDED VEHICLES – Determination and acceptance of submissions for purchases of impounded vehicles should not exceed \$2000.</p>
