PUBLIC HEALTH ACT 2016 – FUNCTIONS OF AN ENFORCEMENT AGENCY

Function to be performed:	<p>To exercise the powers or duties conferred or imposed on a local government, as an enforcement agency, under the <i>Public Health Act 2016</i>, relating to:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) Designating Authorised Officers; 2) Preparing and providing to the Chief Health Officer, the Local Government's report on the performance of its functions, or a report detailing any proceedings for an offence under the Act.

Delegate:	<p>In relation to 1) above: Chief Executive Officer</p> <p>In relation to 2) above: Executive Manager Development and Compliance Principal Environmental Health Officer</p>

Express Power to Delegate/Sub-Delegate:	<p><i>Public Health Act 2016:</i> s.21(1)(b)(i) Enforcement agency may delegate to CEO</p>
Express Power or Duty Delegated:	<p><i>Public Health Act 2016:</i> s.22 Reports by and about enforcement agencies s.24 Designation of Authorised Officers</p>
Conditions / Exceptions:	<p>s.21 provides that powers may only be delegated to the CEO <u>OR</u> Authorised officer designated under s.24</p>
Duration of delegation:	Until next annual review
