

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

CLOSING OF CERTAIN THOROUGHFARES TO VEHICLES

Function to be performed:	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) To close any thoroughfare that the City manages for the passage of vehicles, wholly or partially, for a period <u>not exceeding</u> four (4) weeks; 2) To close any thoroughfare that the City manages for the passage of vehicles, wholly or partially, for a period <u>exceeding</u> four (4) weeks; 3) To revoke an order to close a thoroughfare; 4) To partially and temporarily close a thoroughfare without public notice for repairs or maintenance, where it is unlikely to have a significant adverse effect on users of the thoroughfare; 5) To notify affected owners and give public notice that allows reasonable time for submissions to be made and consider any submissions made before determining to fix or alter the level or alignment of a thoroughfare or draining water from a thoroughfare to private land.

Where a thoroughfare is closed without advance public notice, local public notice of the closure is to occur as soon as practicable.</p> <p>In respect of part 2) above:</p> <p>Prior to a decision being made to close a thoroughfare, local public notice of the intentions and reasons for the closure should be undertaken. In addition, consideration of any submissions received should take place.</p>
