This application is for filming and stills photography on council owned property, in open spaces and outdoor areas such as footpaths, roads and parks within the City of Mandurah area. Please note the following document does not constitute a filming permit or location contract.

Prior to submitting this application, please ensure you have made contact with the City of Mandurah Film Liaison Officer to discuss the production and identify potential issues or protocols that may need to be observed.

Your application will be acknowledged within one week as confirmation of the City of Mandurah's receipt of application. It is the applicant's responsibility to contact the City of Mandurah if your application is not acknowledged.

Please note the following timeframes:

Brief synopsis

- Applications for filming that do not have any impact on traffic flow or significant pedestrian
 impact must be submitted as soon as possible to ensure availability, however, no less than two
 weeks prior to the proposed filming date.
- Applications that do require traffic management planning or significant pedestrian management must be submitted no less than eight weeks prior to the proposed filming date.
