What's one thing you're looking forward to doing here?

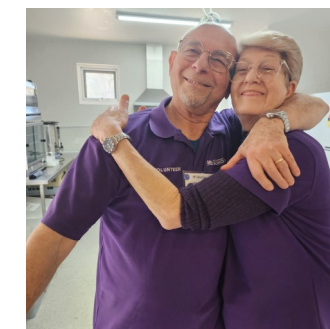
Really getting to know people.
