GENERAL INFORMATION

Dolphin Quay

Dolphin Quay is open 7 days a week. The Centre Manager can be contacted Mon – Fri on Tel 63243200.

Electricity

Each berth is serviced by an electricity bollard. The supply voltage is 240v and 50Hz supplied by plug sockets, which accommodate 15amp Australian plug. When plugging into the bollard ensure you have a compliant power cord (refer to Marina Pen Agreement Terms & Conditions) and use the securing hooks alongside the plug socket to prevent the power cord from sagging or falling into the water. Power cords can be purchased from the Marina Administration Centre.

Fuel

Marine fuel can be purchased from the outlet located on the Commercial Wharf. The fuel outlet is self-service and operates 24 hours a day. Users of this facility must be account holders of Baileys Marine Fuels Australia (BMFA). To open an account with BMFA please visit their website at www.baileysmarine.com.au or contact their head office on 9335.7822.

Penholders Launderette

A launderette is located at the back of the Marina Administration Centre, just a short minute walk from the marina gatehouse. The launderette can be accessed 24 hours a day by the marina security key. There is no additional cost to use the launderette. Please note that washing powder is not supplied.

Telephone

There is a public payphone located opposite the Marina Administration Centre near the pedestrian footbridge.

Transport

There is a daily bus service to Perth from the Mandurah Bus Station which is a five-minute drive away from the marina. A local bus service is in town at the Mandurah Foreshore, approximately 15 minutes' walk.







Refuse

General rubbish can be placed in the bins outside the Gatehouse. Waste oil can be disposed at the Waste Oil facility on the commercial wharf.

Weather Forecast

Daily weather forecasts and tide times can be obtained from the Marina Administration Centre.
