

# Intercultural Lullabies Celebration

**Social Story**



This social story is for guests attending the **Intercultural Lullabies Celebration**, during the Mandurah Arts Festival 2021.

This document contains information about coming to the event at Mandurah Performing Arts Centre (ManPAC), including images and information about the venue, and information about the event.

## The Venue



The **Intercultural Lullabies Celebration** will be held at the Mandurah Performing Arts Centre on **Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> November** from **3.30 – 4.30pm**.

There are parking options available close by, off **Ormsby Terrace** near the Mandurah Performing Arts Centre.



When you arrive, walk down the pathway along Mandjar Square, towards ManPAC.





As you walk towards the Mandurah Performing Arts Centre building you will see the cinema on the opposite side.



This is the entry door located at the end of the pathway.



There is a button to use which can open this door for people who use a wheelchair or find the door hard to open.





This is a photo of a large space, called the foyer, which you will see when you enter the ManPAC. You will use hand sanitiser when we enter, and either you or someone with you will check in using a smartphone or a pen and paper.



There may be people who greet you when you enter. This is a photo of people at a table greeting people as they arrive at the ManPAC.



At the event there will be a choir on the stage, singing songs. You can request a book with the words of the songs to join in the singing, and have a great time.





There will be a person doing Auslan. This person will do sign language so that people who cannot hear the singers will be able to watch the sign language. This is a picture of someone doing sign language.



If you need a break there will be a quiet space, called a Quiet Zone, where you can go to relax within the Mandurah Performing Arts Centre.



There will be a photographer at the event taking photos. The photographer will ask you if you would like your photo taken.



The toilets are through a corridor off from the foyer area. This is a picture of the hallway to the male and female toilets.



The wheelchair accessible bathroom is a bit further along. Volunteers and staff at the ManPAC can help you to find the toilet if you feel a bit lost.



This is a picture of the wheelchair accessible bathroom.

If you have any questions, or need help during the event, there will be lots of friendly staff around to help you.
