Guidelines

A social story™ explains new experiences and environments. Anyone who is nervous about attending a place or event for the first time may benefit from access to a social story.

We recommend you follow these guidelines.

- Read the social story preferably two weeks in advance of the visit.
- If reading to someone, help the person to understand key points.
- Read the social story more than once, in a quiet and calm space.



This event will be held at the Dudley Park Child and Parent Centre.

The centre is surrounded by big grassy areas with a playground.





The Child and Parent Centre does not have ACROD parking.

A temporary ACROD parking sign will be installed close to the entrance.

There is a level pathway to the event.
