Access Participation & Inclusion Grant Guidelines



Background

The City of Mandurah in partnership with Disabilities Services Commission are committed to promoting access, participation and inclusion of people with a disability in community life.

Raising the visibility of people with a disability in everyday places normalises and encourages social inclusion. Removing barriers and making events, activities and programs more accessible, reduces isolation and increases the health, well-being and independence of people with a disability.

Grant Information

The grant aims to assist with the cost of hosting an event, activity or program that promotes access, participation and inclusion of people with a disability.

Grant applications are open for the whole financial year. An organisation can apply for up to \$500 per financial year. Larger amounts will be considered for significant events in consultation with a Community Development Officer.

The grant will close once all funds have been allocated.

If successful, a committee member from your organisations will be required to attend a workshop facilitated by Inclusion WA.

Who can apply?

- Incorporated, not-for-profit organisations
- Community groups (would need to be auspiced by incorporated not-for-profit organisation

We look for:

Applications need to address at least one of the Access Participate Inclusion objectives:

- to raise awareness of the contributions of people with a disability in our community
- to provide activities and initiatives enabling a high level of participation for people with a disability
- to promote inclusive events or programs linking people with a disability to the community

- Marketing and advertising costs
- Expert or specialist to deliver project or speak at event
- Catering, food and drink (non-alcoholic)
- Insurance
- Venue and equipment hire
- Project materials

Application process

- 1. Speak to a Community Development Officer about your idea (phone: 9550 3275)
 - To confirm eligibility
 - To seek feedback and get assistance with your idea.
- 2. Visit the City of Mandurah, Community Grants webpage for more information.
- 3. Complete online application

What happens next?

- We will assess your funding application.
- All applicants are notified of the grant decision in writing, within seven days of submitting your application.
- If successful, you will receive a letter of offer, which requires your acceptance of the conditions of the funding.
- If successful, a representative from your organisations will be required to attend a two (2) hour workshop facilitated by Inclusion WA.
