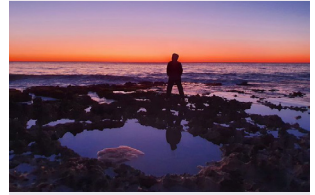

ABOUT THE COLOURS OF MANDURAH

The Colours of Mandurah is a colourful walkway linking Mandjar Square to our world class Mandurah Ocean Marina in just 250 steps. These colours reflect the vibrancy of Mandurah and its connection to the land and water, inspired by our people, places and stories.

This 'street art' project installed between Ormsby Terrace and Keith Holmes Reserve aims to enhance the pedestrian connection between Mandjar Square and Mandurah Ocean Marina.

The project was done in partnership with RAC through its Reconnect WA initiative, which was created to help revitalise streets and public spaces to better connect people and places.
