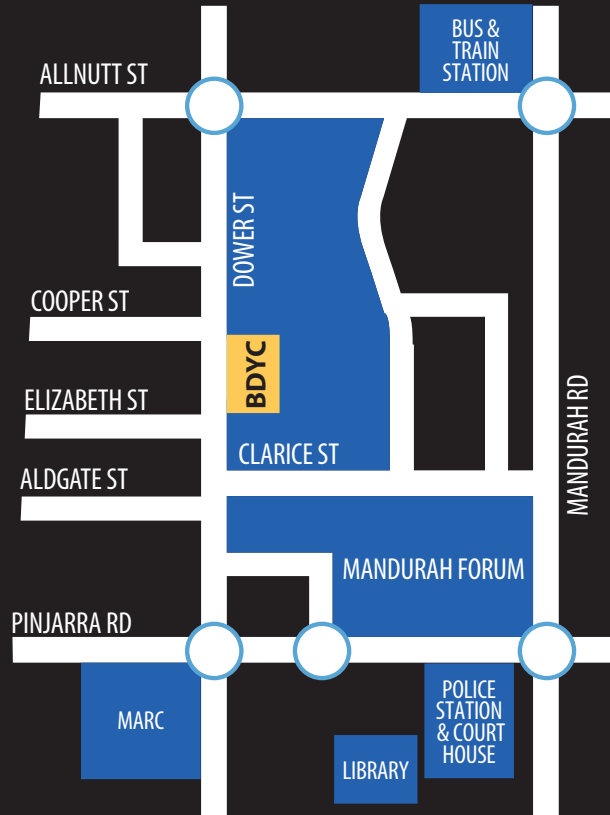
Friday Night Skillz
