If you are between 11 - 25 years you can apply for up to \$350 to achieve something great.

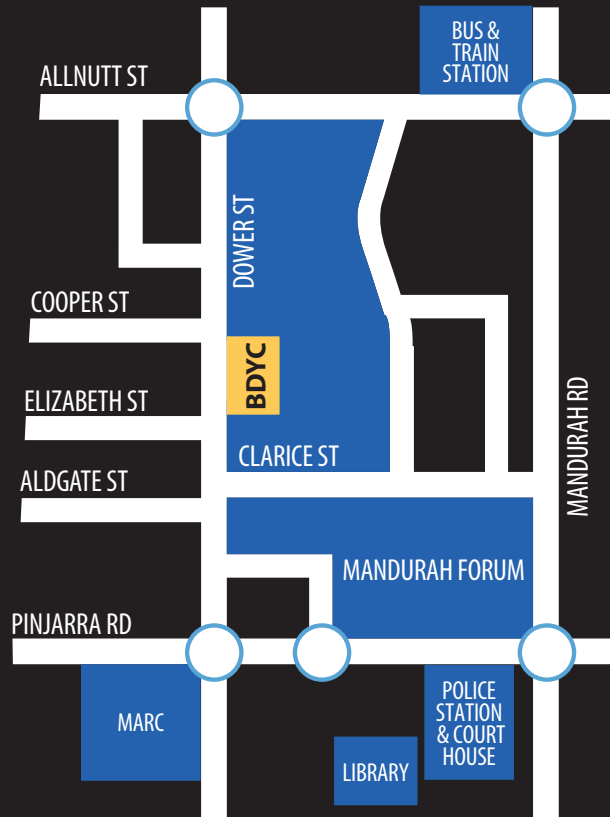
