

Nikki Wise Community Services Memorial Scholarship Guidelines

General Information

The Nikki Wise Community Services Memorial Scholarship is provided by the City of Mandurah to honour the legacy of Nikki Wise. Nikki was devoted to helping those in need and sadly passed in September 2016. This annual scholarship will assist other passionate members of the Mandurah community wishing to study in the area of community services with \$2000 being awarded to one successful applicant annually.

Who can apply?

The following eligibility criteria applies to the Nikki Wise Community Services Scholarship. Please ensure you meet the following criteria prior to completing the scholarship application form:

1. Student must be enrolled full-time in an Undergraduate degree or TAFE Diploma or Certificate IV at an accredited tertiary institution.
2. Student must be a current resident of the City of Mandurah
3. Student must be an Australian citizen or permanent resident
4. Student must demonstrate academic achievement and a commitment to contributing to the Mandurah community.
5. Student must be studying a course that relates to the Community Services Sector to the satisfaction of the panel, excluding direct health care provision (e.g. Nursing, Medicine and Physiotherapy).

Grant Rounds

The scholarship will be offered yearly to one lucky applicant in line with the July Community Partnership Fund Round. Please see the City of Mandurah Grants page for details on round opening and closing dates.

Please note in its first year two scholarship rounds will be offered with the first round opening on April 10 2018 and closing on May 10 2018.
