

HONORARY FREEMAN OF THE CITY

POLICY

POL-CMR 02

Objective:

To provide a process by which Council can formally recognise outstanding and meritorious service of an individual to the community of the City of Mandurah.

Statement:

Council may resolve by an absolute majority, to bestow the honorary title of 'Freeman of the City' upon any person who is a resident of the City of Mandurah who has satisfied the following criteria:

- (1) provided a quality of service significantly benefiting the community for a period no less than 10 years;
- (2) has assisted in the advancement of the City's strategic direction; and
- (3) has provided benefit for the greater community in an outstanding, distinguished and meritorious manner that exceeds contributions of most other persons.

Any person to whom the title of Honorary Freeman of the City has been conferred may designate themselves 'Honorary Freeman of the City of Mandurah', and shall be invited to all subsequent formal civic functions conducted by the City.
