

# BURIAL PLOTS

## POLICY

POL-PBH 01

### Objective:

To ensure capacity limitations are placed on individual burial plots at City of Mandurah controlled cemeteries.

### Statement:

#### Definitions:

Interment – means the burial of a coffin or placement of ashes within a plot.

#### Lakes Lawn Cemetery

The Lakes Lawn cemetery is the only cemetery under the control of the City where new burials are accepted. The City provides for each burial plot to have up to four (4) interments with a maximum of three (3) coffin burials.

#### Old Mandurah Cemetery

New burials are not permitted at the Old Mandurah Cemetery as this is a 'closed' cemetery. Exceptions for interments are extended to those persons who have pre-approval or if a member of the family has been buried at the cemetery. The Old Mandurah cemetery allows for two (2) interments per burial plot.

The right to place memorials in either cemetery mentioned above will be in accordance with the City of Mandurah Cemeteries Local Law 2010.
