

Building and Construction Industry Worker (Restrictions on access) Directions

On 20 October 2021 the WA Government announced its mandatory COVID-19 vaccination policy to prepare the community for expected community transmission of COVID-19 and safeguard essential services and businesses over the long-term. The Building and Construction Industry Worker (Restrictions on Access) Directions No.2 were issued on 2 December 2021 and were revoked on 31 December 2021. The WA Government subsequently issued the Building and Construction Industry Worker (Restrictions on Access) Directions No.3 (PH Directions) which applies to City of Mandurah Sites.

To meet the WA Government legislative requirements, the City of Mandurah will require all contractors who attend a City of Mandurah Site to be fully vaccinated by 31 January 2022.

By attending the City's site after this date, you are agreeing to adhere to the COVID-19 requirements of the City, the WA Government and the WA Department of Health at the time of entry, including:

- Declaring you and all building and construction workers are fully vaccinated with an approved vaccination, or have an approved exemption;
- The employer of the building and construction worker has met their obligations and has collected and maintains a record of the vaccination status of their building and construction workers;
- Not roster on or permit any building and construction worker on a City of Mandurah Site who is not compliant with the PH Directions or any future Public Health Directions;
- Ensuring that any subcontractors that are engaged are informed of their obligations as outlined in these guidelines; and
- Declaring you are well and without COVID-19 symptoms - If you're unwell, you must not attend site.

All contractors must provide proof of their vaccination status at the request of a City of Mandurah authorised officer.
