Barb Haddy's intense interest in this locale of the Western Coastal Plain and its past and present history both real and imagined, leads this new body of exploratory works on paper and canvas.



The CASM Studio Residency Program supports emerging contemporary artists to investigate new ideas and develop work in a comfortable and engaging environment over a three-month period.

The 2022 residency artists are:

Jan – Mar | Marie Mitchell: Works in fibre, fabric and stitch using reclaimed, upcycled materials.

Apr – Jun | Youth Residence, Isobella Richmond: Expresses herself through oil painting, pencil, charcoal, oil pastels and more.

Jul – Sep | Tiffany Forster: A watercolour and pastel artist striving to capturing the effects of light.

Oct – Dec | Claire Pannell: A sound artist who works in the field of STEAM. An explorer of collage and stop motion animation.

The Koolbardi Bidi Garden showcases over 60 species of local native plants.

Each plant has a story to tell, of use in traditional Noongar culture or contemporary art practices.

The garden features community art , informative signage and a Noongar-English word wall and is maintained by the CASM staff and volunteers.


