



Changing Places

Improving community access



Changing Places are secure facilities designed for people with disability who require bathroom assistance while in the community. They are equipped with a ceiling hoist, adult-size change table, accessible toilet and space for two support people.

Access to a Changing Places facility

Access to Changing Places is through a Master Locksmiths Access Key (MLAK), ensuring the facilities are available for people who need them. Loan keys are not provided in Mandurah.

An MLAK also provides access to the Caterpillar Park Liberty Swing and the beach wheelchairs on Mandurah's Eastern Foreshore.

Companion Card holders automatically qualify for a free MLAK. If you're not a cardholder, you may still be eligible. Contact the National Disability Services.
