When and where is the event?

What is the Community Safety Expo?

A free, family-friendly event showcasing safety services, organisations, and community groups. With over 40 stalls and activation stations and a diverse range of safety topics being addressed, the Expo will provide practical tips and information to help keep your family and community safe.



What can I expect?

- 40+ stalls and activities
 - Police, fire, and emergency services
 - Child-friendly games and activities
 - Free coffee
 - Ice-cream van, hot chips and soft drink available to purchase
 - Constable Care Puppet Shows
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Is the event family-friendly?

Yes! There will be activities for children, including art and craft, opportunities to explore emergency service vehicles, Constable Care Puppet Shows, Amy Wild Snake Safety presentations, and an Expo Passport to get stamped at various stalls. Plus lots of information and tips on how to keep safe in your home and out in the community.



Where can I park?

Free parking is available on Rushton Park North oval. Accessible parking is available at Dower Street car park for ACROD holders. Please follow signage and traffic management directions on the day.

How do I get there?

Public transport options: Buses 588, 591, 592, 593, 594, 597, 600, 604 and 605 all stop outside the Expo location.

Bike racks are available onsite and active transport is encouraged.

Will the event go ahead if it rains?

The event will proceed in most weather conditions. Some outdoor elements may be modified in heavy rain. Please check the City's Facebook page on the morning of the event for updates.

What should I bring?

- Reusable water bottle (water refill stations available in Billy Dower Youth Centre and Peel Thunder Platinum Room)
 - Sunscreen and hat
 - Keep Cup for your free tea or coffee
 - A sense of community spirit!
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Are there places to chill out on the day?

- A marquee with table and chairs will be located in the Emergency Services Activation Area in the car park
 - The Bear Trap, accessed from the car park behind the Peel Thunder stall, will be open with limited food options and places to sit under shade.
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Can I bring my pet?

For safety reasons, we ask that pets be left at home unless they are assistance animals.

Will there be videos and photographs taken at the event?

Photography and video recording will happen to capture the fun and excitement of this event.

If you'd prefer not to be photographed, please advise the photographers on the day.

Is the event accessible?

- Wheelchair and stroller accessible
 - Step-free indoor access and accessible restrooms (with baby changing)
 - Accessible parking for ACROD holders
