About this visual story

This visual story has been created to support people attending *Peel Makers' Market*.

It explains what to expect during the event and helps people feel prepared and comfortable before attending.



Event information

Peel Makers' Market is a free event that is part of the Mandurah Arts Festival.

The market is a place where people come together to explore stalls, look at products, enjoy food, and spend time with family and friends.

The market will run for 7 hours from 10am – 5pm.



Location

The market will take place along Smart Street, George Robinson Gardens, and the Eastern Foreshore in Mandurah.

There are footpaths and accessible pathways around the area to help people move between the market stalls and activities.

This is an outdoor event.



Parking

Standard parking is available along Smart Street, Mandurah Terrace, and nearby Eastern Foreshore car parks.

ACROD parking bays are available in the Eastern Foreshore car parks and nearby city centre parking areas.

Parking may be busy, especially during events and weekends, so allow extra time to find a parking space and walk to the event.



Public transport

You can catch a bus to the Eastern Foreshore. Bus stops are located nearby on Smart Street and Mandurah Terrace.

At the markets

The market may be a busy place with people walking around, talking, and exploring the stalls.

You may:

- hear music, conversations, and sounds from different activities.
- smell food at some stalls and trucks.
- see market stalls, tables, displays, and decorations.
- see people selling food, handmade items, and other products.
- see families, children, community members, stallholders, and event staff.



Special Activities

During the market, there will be different activities and performances happening throughout the day.

There will be three special activities you can experience:

- *The Playful Plate*
- *Sustainable Creation Stations*
- *Off Axis*

You can choose what you would like to watch or join in with.



The Playful Plate

10am – 3pm

Eastern Foreshore

Inside a red, cage-like structure, you will see a pop-up restaurant with no food.

Two performers will guide you through a fun and interactive theatre experience using stories, imagination, and play.

You can watch, listen, or join in.

You can take part in your own way.

No bookings are needed.



Sustainable Creation Stations

10am – 5pm

Smart Street Mall

There will be a creative space with recycled materials.

You will see tables filled with interesting materials and friendly facilitators who can help you create something new.

This activity is suitable for all ages and creative abilities.

No bookings are needed.



Off Axis

12pm – 2pm

George Robinson Gardens

This is a fun family performance with acrobatics, juggling, and clowning.

There will be two performers sharing silly ideas, tricks, and laughs while working together.

After the show, you can join a circus workshop and try activities such as juggling, hula hoops, and spinning plates.

You can watch the performance or join in with the activities in your own way.



Food and drink

There will be food trucks at the event from which you can buy food and drinks.

Sometimes the wait for food can take a while.



Noise levels and taking breaks

The market may be a busy place with people walking around and activities happening.

If you need a break, you can move to a quieter area nearby.

There are open spaces around the market where you can take some time away from the crowd.



Toilets

The Eastern Foreshore toilet facilities are located near the Tuckey Street roundabout and parking area.

There are also toilets in George Robinson Gardens.

The toilet block includes accessible toilets for people who need them.
