

Museum 'Sea Creatures' Colouring Competition

Terms and conditions

Participation in the competition is deemed as acceptance of these Terms and Conditions:

1. The "City" refers to the City of Mandurah.
2. The "Competition" refers to the Museum 'Sea Creatures' Colouring Competition organised by the City.
3. The "Entrant" refers to the child (12 years old and under) and their parent/guardian who is entering the Competition.
4. The "Prize" is **A Mandurah Cruises Family Pass (2 adults and 2 children) for the Dolphin Cruise & Views Tour (1 hour 15 minutes), valued at \$98.**

Total prize pool value: \$98. (Prize is as stated and not exchangeable for cash.)

5. The closing date ("Closing Date") of the Competition is **Friday, 16 October 2026, 3pm.**
6. Colouring pages can be collected from Mandurah Museum, 3 Pinjarra Rd, Mandurah WA 6210 or any of the City of Mandurah Libraries (Mandurah Library - 331 Pinjarra Rd, Mandurah WA 6210, Lakelands Library and Community Centre - 49 Banksiadale Gate, Lakelands WA 6180, or Falcon Library and Community Centre - Cobblers Rd & Flavia St, Falcon WA 6210) between 12 August and 9 October as part of the Sea Monsters: Prehistoric Ocean Predators Exhibition.
7. A "Valid Entry" means a colouring page with completed contact details and submitted to the City of Mandurah Museum, 3 Pinjarra Rd, Mandurah WA 6210, or any of the City of Mandurah Libraries (Mandurah Library - 331 Pinjarra Rd, Mandurah WA 6210, Lakelands Library and Community Centre - 49 Banksiadale Gate, Lakelands WA 6180, or Falcon Library and Community Centre - Cobblers Rd & Flavia St, Falcon WA 6210) by the Closing Date.
8. Only one Valid Entry will be accepted per Entrant.
9. The "Winner" refers to the Entrant selected to receive the Prize.
10. Winners will be chosen by the City based on the best judged entry. The judging will take place at the City of Mandurah Museum on Tuesday, 20 October 2026. The judging will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
11. Winners will be notified by phone on Tuesday, 20 October 2026. If the Winner does not make contact with the City by Friday 23 October 3pm, then the Winner will forfeit their Prize and the City may, in its sole discretion, redraw a new Winner of the forfeited Prize.
12. The City, in their absolute discretion, may disqualify Entrants and/or Winners who bring the Competition into disrepute or who breach these terms and conditions.
13. Except for any liability that cannot be excluded by law, all prize winners shall indemnify the City from all claims, costs, losses (whether direct or indirect) including any interest, injury or death, penalties, legal and other professional fees and expenses awarded against or incurred by the winner as a result of their use of their prize.
14. The City retains ownership of the intellectual property that it has specifically developed in relation to this competition. All other intellectual property remains the property of the creator.
15. City of Mandurah Elected Members, employees and family members are ineligible to enter.

16. The City reserves the right to photograph and/or video-record the Winners' prize collection and use the subsequent images for promotional purposes.
17. The City reserves the right to cancel, suspend or terminate the Competition without notice.
18. Any personal information collected in the Competition will solely be used for purposes connected to this Competition. Entry is conditional in providing this information.
