

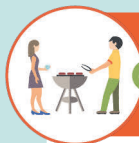

Go ahead!

Small, low-risk activities (temporary, non permanent infrastructure) you can do without City approval.

Examples

- Chalk art on footpaths
- Poster paint on pathways
- Plant/seed/produce swaps
- Neighbourhood gatherings in local parks (under 50 people, no alcohol or amusements)
- Community clean-ups
- Meet-ups and picnics
