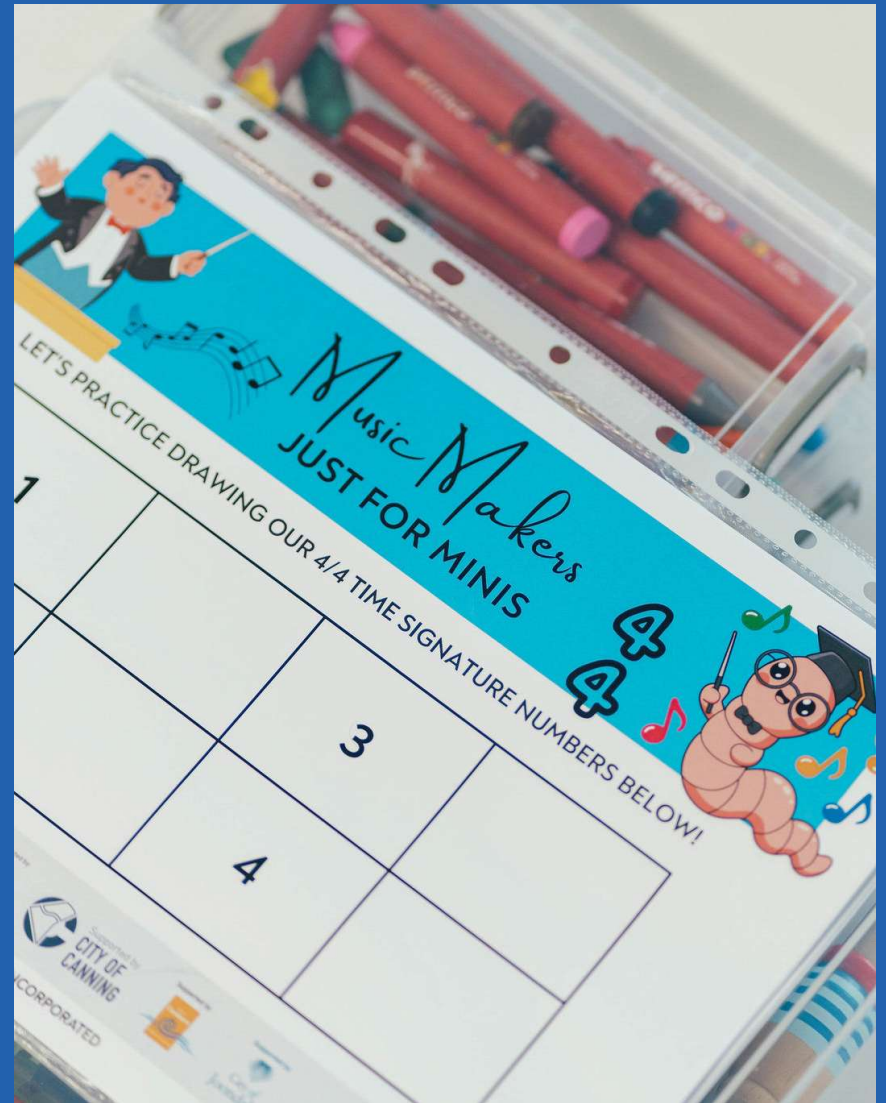


Visual Story

About this visual story

This visual story has been created to support people attending *Music Makers Just For Minis*.

It explains what to expect during the event and helps children feel prepared and comfortable before attending.

There is a section at the end for parents and caregivers.



Event information

Music Makers Just for Minis is a fun workshop for children aged 2–5 years and their parent, carer, or grandparent.

It runs for 40 minutes and includes music, crafting, and play.

Children must be with an adult during the session.



Location

The event will take place at Falcon Library.

Inside, there are bookshelves, desks, computers, and spaces where people can read, learn, and take part in activities.

The venue has wheelchair access, and there is a flat pathway to the entrance to help people enter the building safely.



Location

There will be signs to show you to the right room for the session.

Staff can also help you.



Parking

Standard and ACROD Parking can be found in the car park off Flavia Street.

Parking can sometimes be busy at the library.



Public transport

You can take a bus to a spot nearby and walk to the library.

You can take your music-maker home at the end of the session.

The session is fun, interactive, and made just for young children.

Location

The event takes place at the Falcon Library and Community Centre:
Cobblers Road & Flavia Street, Falcon WA 6210

Arriving at the Venue

Enter Falcon Library via Cobbler Road or Flavia Street.

There is a parking area at the back of the building.
Please arrive roughly 5 minutes before the event starts.

Tickets

Your name will be on the attendance list, but please have your e-ticket ready on your phone, just in case.



What to bring

If your child needs anything to be comfortable in the session, like fidget toys or noise-reducing headphones, you can bring these along.
